In 1788 Parish vingteniers collected population details to provide information to the English Parliament relevant to the Jersey knitting industry. The original record is held in the Société Jersiaise Library. Marie Louise Backhurst transcribed the data for an article in the 1980/81 edition of the Channel Islands Family History Society Journal.
